doctor to develop a
personalized health
plan for improving
health and preventing
disease. You should

take this opportunity to discuss with your doctor the preventive services needed to keep you healthy and address any healthcare concerns you may have. In addition to your general health, your physician is likely to discuss the following topics with you:

- The annual flu and pneumonia vaccinations.
- Your exercise regimen and diet.
- Your mental health and whether you are feeling sad or depressed.
- Urinary functions or bladder control issues.
- How to prevent falls.
- Tobacco use and how to quit.

Your physician may also discuss Advance Directives (also called a living will or power of attorney for healthcare) with you, to support your healthcare decisions and your wishes.

MEDICARE DIABETES PREVENTION PROGRAM (MDPP)

Beginning April 1, 2018, MDPP services will be covered for eligible Medicare beneficiaries under all Medicare health plans.

MDPP is a structured health behavior change intervention that provides practical training in long-term dietary change, increased physical activity, and problem-solving strategies for overcoming challenges to sustaining weight loss and a healthy lifestyle.
